#### LIGHTING OF THE ADVENT WREATH – The Oil Lamp

The 1<sup>st</sup> candle is relit.

<u>Voice 1</u>: An oil lamp shines into the night, a pinpoint of light in the midst of darkness. Our eyes will find even the tiniest spark of light when everything around is pitch black. Even a simple oil lamp reveals the power of light, exposing a path through the darkest spaces and the scariest moments. A lamp shining in the darkness welcomes us in from our wandering. Its warmth pushes our worries away and the darkness is rendered powerless.

# <u>All</u>: But what is an oil lamp without hands to strike the match to light it? A lamp cannot light itself. What is a light without hands to hold it up, so it shines into all those dark corners where worries and fears await? What is a lamp without hands to open the door to let the lamplight shine out into the world?

<u>Voice 1</u>: A lamp needs a person to look into the darkness and see who needs the light. A lamp needs a person to light the wick and set it shining. A lamp needs a person to open the door and hold it high. A lamp needs a person that will welcome the stranger into the light, into the warmth and into the hearts of those who know the light already.

<u>All</u>: O God, shine your light into our lives in every moment of darkness and murkiness. Warm our hearts so that we will open our doors to your love. May we be the people to shine light into the dark corners of your world. May ours be the lives that welcome you to be born again in our midst this Christmas.

The 2<sup>nd</sup> candle is lit.

<u>All</u>: We light the second candle of the Advent wreath to symbolize the lamp and the light it brings into the world as it drives the darkness away. The light shines in the darkness and the darkness does not overcome it.
