DEACON'S WELCOME

LIGHTING OF THE ADVENT WREATH - The Staff

The 1st & 2nd candles are relit.

<u>DEACON</u>: A staff is a simple thing. It's cut from a tree and carved into something useful. A staff is just a walking stick, sturdy and dependable, something to lean on when you are weary. For a shepherd, like those who cared for the sheep on the outskirts of Bethlehem, a staff provided extra support when the path was rocky. It could also be used to give a stubborn sheep a gentle prod to move along to the next green pasture or the staff's crook used to rescue a wayward lamb.

<u>All</u>: But what is a staff without hands to grip it firmly? What is a staff without hands to place it wisely for support? What is a staff without hands to prod the sheep on to new pastures or rescue silly lambs from danger?

<u>DEACON</u>: A staff needs a person to test its strength. A staff needs a person to lean on its dependability. A staff needs a person who knows the sheep and sees when they go astray. A staff needs a person unafraid of danger, willing to kneel down in the mud to rescue the sheep and lead it forward.

<u>All</u>: Lord Jesus Christ, we seek you in this Advent season. Be our staff to lean on when we lose our footing. Be our guide when we cannot find our way. Pull us free from danger. Sweet Baby Jesus, rescue us with the light of your love. Be our strength each day so that we may live with courage and compassion, come what may. Amen.

The 3rd candle is lit.

<u>All</u>: We light the third candle of the Advent wreath to symbolize the staff which offers strength, safety and support when needed to move forward into each new day. The light shines in the darkness and the darkness does not overcome it.
